

This 2024-04 Competition Directive was initiated by H1 Chairman Mike Denslow, Chief Referee Jonathan Abbott, and Assistant Referees Matt Yarno and Sam Houghtaling clarifying the procedure used in a Round Robin format.

Following is an addition to rule:

## **RACING RULES**

## **C. COMPLETED HEATS & RESTARTS**

## 8. ROUND ROBIN RACE FORMAT

A random ball draw for round robin positions will be made with the top qualifier drawing first, the second top qualifier drawing second and so forth.

In the event the race is shortened due to weather or racing conditions, and after at least 2 heats have been run, any boat that has run more heats than the others will drop their points from the last heat ran.

Format for 5 Boats: (Note:) Draw 1=A, 2=B, 3=C, 4=D, 5=E

- (Heat 1) A, B, C, D
- (Heat 2) B, C, D, E All boats 1x, B, C, D = 2x
- (Heat 3) A, B, C, E All boats 2x, B, C = 3x
- (Heat 4) A, C, D, E All boats 3x, C = 4x
- (Heat 5) A, B, D, E All boats 5x

Format for 6 Boats: (Note:) Draw 1=A, 2=B, 3=C, 4=D, 5=E, 6=F

- (Heat 1) A, B, C, D
- (Heat 2) C, D, E, F All boats 1x, 2 have run = 2x
- (Heat 3) A, B, E, F All boats 2x
- (Heat 4) A, C, D, E All boats 2x, 2 have run = 3x
- (Heat 5) B, F, E, C All boats 3x, 2 have run 4x
- (Heat 6) A, B, F, D All boats have run 3x
