

COMPETITION DIRECTIVE 2024 – 07

This 2024-07 Competition Directive was initiated by H1 Chairman Mike Denslow, Chief Referee Jonathan Abbott, and Assistant Referees Matt Yarno and Sam Houghtaling to re-define Overlap distances.

This Competition Directive supersedes CD 2024-03 dated 6/29/24 regarding overlap.

This Competition Directive also includes a revision on the definition of entering the racecourse or racing lanes in reference to interfering with boats already established in a racing lane. (Section 8 below)

Following are the affected rules:

RACING RULES

D. NAVIGATING THE COURSE / RIGHT OF WAY

- 5. As between two boats
 - c. "Overlap" means:
 - (i) A **rooster tail length**, or a minimum of **7 Boat lengths**, whichever is greater at the time of the overtake. The overlap rule applies from the beginning of the warm-up period until the end of the race.
- 8. Any Boat entering the racecourse or racing lanes at any time **must not interfere** with a Boat or Boats that are on the racecourse or running in established lanes. Current Overlap rules shall apply.
